Statement on Children Held at the US Southern Border

As Sisters of Saint Joseph, who uphold the inalienable dignity of all persons, we urge President Donald Trump and the United States Congress to act immediately to remedy the deplorable conditions in which migrant children are being held at the United States Southern Border. This includes providing children with the basic necessities (food, clean water, fresh clothing, diapers, proper sanitation, medicine, medical attention, comfortable, warm bedding and sleeping areas), supervision by qualified caregivers, humane treatment, and a clean, safe environment. These children deserve to be treated respectfully and compassionately. We trust that you will address and rectify the degrading conditions in which they find themselves.
